

ILLL Capacity-Building Workshop for International Students on

The Institute of Life Long Learning, University of Delhi organized a capacity-building workshop for international students of various disciplines on 11th November, 2016. Shormishtha Panja Director, ILLL welcomed the participants and informed them about the initiatives taken by the ILLL in the field of e-learning and the ongoing projects, such as NMEICT and the MOOC project.
